REGION: Veneto

GRAPE TYPE: 51% Pinot Grigio, 49% Pinot Bianco

COLOR: Straw yellow

BOUQUET: Intense and persistent with a light fragrance of bread crust

TASTE: A smooth, well balanced and fruity white wine with pear and vanilla undertones

RECOMMENDED DISHES: Seafood, cheeses, vegetable soups and light meat dishes

SERVE: Chilled; 50° F (10° C)
