

DOMAINE DE BOISSEYT

SAINT JOSEPH LES GARIPÉLÉES BLANC



GROWING REGION:

Saint Joseph appellation in the northern Rhône Valley, France.

TERROIR:

From three parcels. 'Les Garipélées' is old Provençal referring to ground without grass, i.e., super stony.

GRAPES:

Marsanne 50%, Roussanne 50%.

VINIFICATION NOTES:

Aged in large (400-liter), neutral barrels for 6 months. Production 500 cases annually.

TASTING NOTES:

A rich, textured, deliciously dry wine--and a really nice alternative to Chardonnay!
